To ensure the safety of our staff, volunteers, and customers — and to comply with health and safety standards — our thrift store cannot accept certain items. Please review this list before donating. Thank you for understanding and supporting our mission!

Furniture & Large Items

- Mattresses, box springs, and bed frames (especially used)
- Upholstered furniture with stains, tears, and odors
- Cribs, playpens, or car seats (safety and recall concerns)
- Pianos, organs, or large entertainment centers
- Broken or incomplete furniture

Electronics & Appliances

- Tube (CRT) TVs and computer monitors
- Old printers, fax machines, or scanners
- Non-working electronics or appliances
- Items with cut cords or exposed wiring
- Large appliances (refrigerators, stoves, washers, dryers)

Hazardous or Safety Items

- Paint, chemicals, gasoline, or propane tanks
- Automotive fluids or batteries
- Weapons, ammunition, or fireworks
- Smoke detectors or carbon monoxide alarms
- Opened cleaning or beauty products

Clothing & Textiles

- Soiled, torn, or mildewed clothing
- Undergarments or swimsuits (unless new with tags)
- Wet or moldy fabrics, pillows, or comforters
- Used bedding or mattresses

Children's Items

- Cribs or bassinets (safety recalls)
- Car seats, strollers, or walkers
- Toys with missing parts or safety concerns

Medical & Personal Care Items

- Prescription medications or medical supplies
- Used medical equipment (CPAPs, needles, walkers)
